## Water bottles

Please do not put fruit juice or any other drink but water in your child's water bottle. There are several reasons for this, one being if the drink is spilt fruit juices can stain work surfaces and clothes, another being that sugary drinks (even natural sugars found in fruit) are extremely bad for children's teeth if sipped all day.

#### No lunchtime return

Please note that if your child is absent for a morning session but will be present for an afternoon session the start time is:

Nursery - 12.25pm Reception - 12.45pm KS1 - 1.00pm KS2 - 1.25pm

We can only accept children back into school before this if they were registered at the beginning of the morning session and we know of their return. These are health and safety precautions, as your child will not be recorded as being in school until the afternoon register has been taken. Thank you.

#### Car Park

Please can we ask that **NO** parents bring their cars in to the school grounds at any time. (unless they have express prior permission from the headteacher). The car park is strictly staff only.

Pedestrians should not walk across the car park at any time but use the walkways, as cars may be coming and going throughout the day. There have been occasions when staff are leaving school during the day, at home time and after evening clubs where children are walking across the car park. In the interests of health and safety for your children please do not do this. Thank you.
